



Jobs with the Chubb Corporation

The Chubb Group of Insurance companies serves businesses and individuals around the globe through a wide range of property and casualty insurance offerings. With 120 offices in 27 countries, the Chubb Corporation ranks as the eleventh largest US property and casualty insurer.

The company's roots can be traced back to 1882 when a marine underwriting business was founded, with a focus on insuring ships and cargoes. The business, which was opened by Thomas Caldecott Chubb and his son, led to the formation of the Chubb Corporation in 1967. In 1984, Chubb was listed on the New York Stock Exchange for the first time and today its offerings include more than 170 commercial insurance products, a variety of accident and health insurance options, as well as construction and commercial surety bonds. In fact, Chubb is the fifth largest issuer of US construction and commercial surety bonds and the third largest "package policy" writer. Business insurance offerings include professional and management liability, property and casualty, multinational solutions, industry solutions, and loss control solutions. Personal insurance options offered by the company include automobile, home, valuables, watercraft, and more.

Chubb has subsidiaries within the following areas of service: property and casualty insurance, property and casualty insurance underwriting managers, reinsurance, consulting and claims administration, insurance agencies, and real estate.

Chubb currently employs about 10,500 people in North America, Europe, South America, and the Pacific Rim. Additionally, the company works with 8,500 independent agents and brokers around the world. Chubb employees are eligible to participate in the company's *Total Rewards Program*, which gives employees the opportunity to choose from various benefit options. Employees become benefit-eligible the first month following 30 days of company service. Chubb's US benefits include health care and financial program options, as well as flexible work arrangements, disability coverage, life insurance, personal accident insurance, business travel and accident insurance, and paid time off. Chubb also offers a 401(k) plan, The Chubb CashBuilder Pension Plan, and provides a dollar-for-dollar match to employee social security contributions. Commuter benefits, adoption assistance, and family leave are also available to eligible employees.
