With 14 global manufacturing facilities and a portfolio of more than 13,000 products, Boston Scientific is among the world's largest medical device companies with a focus on less intrusive medicine. Since its establishment in 1979, the company has produced progressive medical products and therapies that serve to provide exceptional clinical results for patients.

Boston Scientific was initially formed as a holding company to acquire Medi-Tech, a leading interventional medicine company. Throughout its history, the company has provided patients with a number of innovative medical options, including major cardiology products, pulse generators, and pain management systems.

The company operates through four major business groups. The Cardiology, Rhythm, and Vascular Group's major practice areas include interventional cardiology cardiac rhythm management and the endovascular unit. The Endoscopy Division's primary practices areas include gastroenterology and pulmonary, while the Urology and Women's Health Division addresses medical issues such as kidney stones, bladder stones, urethral stricture, benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH), incontinence, pelvic floor disorders, and excessive menstrual bleeding. The Neuromodulation Division is primarily focused on pain management.

Boston Scientific is headquartered in Natick, Massachusetts and has operations in the Americas, Europe, the Middle East, Africa, Asia Pacific, and Japan. **Career opportunities** are available in the company's laboratories, manufacturing plants, business divisions, and corporate headquarters. Recent graduates are encouraged to apply for internships, co-ops, rotational programs, and full-time positions. The company offers a two-year Finance Rotation Program and the IS Rotation Program for recent college graduates who seek work experience.

Full-time, regular employees are entitled to a range of benefits that include medical, dental, and vision plan coverage, as well as career advancement opportunities. Additional benefits include paid time off, health and dependent care flexible spending accounts, life insurance, adoption assistance, educational assistance, a 401(k) retirement plan with a company match, and an employee stock ownership program. Certain locations also offer an on-site fitness center, dry cleaning, barbershops, ATMs, a credit union, book fairs, local merchant discounts, a Boston Scientific Company Store, and daycare programs.
