



New York City Department of Education Jobs

Introduction- The New York City Department of Education is a branch of New York City's municipal government which is responsible for managing the public school system in the city. The DOE is the country's largest education system with over 1,700 schools and 1.1 million students. It covers all the five boroughs in the city.



About New York City Department of Education: Due to the series of demands and strikes for control of the community in 1969, John Lindsay, the Mayor of New York City relinquished all mayoral controls over the schools in the city and organized a school system in the 32 community boards and Board of Education. All Middle and Elementary schools were controlled by these community boards. The Board controlled all the high schools.

The school system of the city was reorganized in 2002. The school system control was handed over to the city mayor who then began the reform and reorganization efforts. All community boards were eliminated. The Board of Education was given the name of Panel for Educational Policy. The panel had 12 members of which 5 were appointed by the Borough Presidents while the rest were appointed by the city's mayor.

Employment at New York City Department of Education: The public school system in NYC employs over 135,000 full time employees. The shared mission of the agency and all of its employees is to provide students with quality education along with tools required to succeed in college and in their careers while becoming active community members.

New York City Department of Education employs school teachers that prove to be a key influence on the school children. The assistant principals and principals that are employed by the agency are given the responsibility of inspiring children and leading schools. The New York City Department of Education career opportunities also include positions for lab specialists, school secretaries, parent coordinators and substitute paraprofessionals.

Jobs at New York City Department of Education include positions in the central administration support department. The department not only offers career opportunities to experienced professionals but also has a large number of full time and part time employment opportunities for internships in different areas.
