## Los Angeles Unified School District Jobs

**Introduction-** Los Angeles Unified School District is the largest public school system within California. LAUSD, during the 07-08 year, had 38,494 employees, 45,473 teachers and 694,288 students. After the LA county government, LAUSD is the 2nd largest employer in the county.



**About LAUSD:** LAUSD was at one time composed of two different districts. The LA High School District was formed in the year 1890 and the LA School District was formed in 1853. In July, 1961 Palos Verdes District and LA School District merged to form the LAUSD. The LA high school district at the time changed its name to West County Union District. The Topanga District was annexed in July, 1962.

Over the years LAUSD has attempted several program reforms. At one time schools had been authority over their everyday decisions. During the 1990s, LAAMP and LEARN were created to give more authority to the principals for making changes in the curriculum that would benefit the students.

**Employment at the LAUSD:** LAUSD is the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest employer in the county with 38,494 employees and 45,473 teachers. The District encompasses the LA City as well as many neighboring cities and provides exceptional opportunities to teachers. LAUSD is committed to innovative programs and educational reform aligned to the state standards.
