

Franklin County, OH Government Jobs

Introduction- Franklin County is located in Ohio in United States. It is the 2nd largest county in the state as well as the 34th largest in the country in terms of population.



About Franklin County, OH Government: Franklin County was authorized to be created by the state government on 30th March, 1803. Originally, the county was a part of the Ross County. The residents named the county to honor Benjamin Franklin. Columbus in Franklin County became the state capital of Ohio in 1816.

Before the decision of the state legislature in 1812, the Columbus city had not existed. It was then designed exclusively as the state capital to prepare it for its role in the state's social, economic and political life. By 1816, Franklin County and Columbus grew significantly. The county is home today to Ohio State University, the largest university in the country which had 56,867 enrolled students on the main Columbus campus in fall 2011.

Employment at the Franklin County, OH Government: All **Franklin County, OH Government jobs** are managed by the Department of Human Resources in the county. The department is responsible for all training and human resource activities for the departments and agencies of the Board of Commissioner. Franklin County, OH Government offers a wide range of employment opportunities.

The development and training staff of the county have developed a wide range of training classes to fulfill the needs of all employees and to help them develop skills for career advancement. Periodic training calendars along with descriptions and class schedules are circulated to all the county agencies so the employees can take advantage of the comprehensive training program.

Jobs in Franklin County, OH Government offer a comprehensive benefits package. The county offers an Employee Development Program which has been developed for providing resources and training opportunities to all employees in the county so they can increase their knowledge and skills and can improve their individual performance.

Careers in Franklin County, OH Government also include access to a Health & Wellness Program which has been developed to offer healthcare education as well as coordination services to the county employees so they can maintain a high level of wellness. Full time employees in the county are also eligible for all healthcare benefits. These benefits include life insurance, vision, dental,



chemical dependency/mental health, prescription drug and medical plans. The county also has two deferred compensation plans for retirement benefits.
